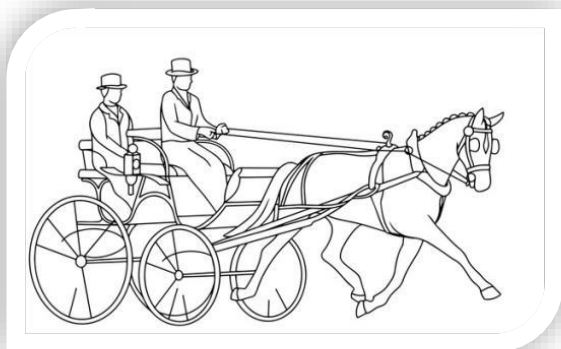

**ROCKY MOUNTAIN CARRIAGE CLUB
DRIVING RELEASE
2025**

Every participant at an event shall constitute an agreement and affirmation that the person making it, owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver and the horse: (1) shall be subject to the constitution and rules of the club and the local rules of the event; (2) that every horse and/or driver is eligible as entered; (3) that the owner and any of his representatives are bound by the constitution and rules of the ADS and event and will accept as final the decision of the hearing committee on any question arising under said rules and agree to hold the event, the ROCKY MOUNTAIN CARRIAGE CLUB, its officials, directors, employees and volunteers harmless for any action taken; (4) that the owner, driver and any of their agents or representatives acknowledge that they participate voluntarily in the event or competition fully aware that horse sports and the event involve inherent dangerous risk, and by participating, they expressly assume any and all risks of injury or loss and they agree to hold the ROCKY MOUNTAIN CARRIAGE CLUB, its directors, employees and volunteers harmless for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the event, whether or not such injury or loss resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligent acts or omissions of said officials, directors, employees or volunteers of ROCKY MOUNTAIN CARRIAGE CLUB.

I agree to be responsible for any damage caused by my entries in this event and that as a condition of my participation, I waive any claim for damage from ROCKY MOUNTAIN CARRIAGE CLUB, and/or its employees and volunteers and the event management for injury or death to persons or animals or for loss, damage or destruction of personal property.

Under Colorado law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities pursuant to Section 13-21-119, Colorado Revised Statutes.

In case of emergency, I authorize an agent of the Rocky Mountain Carriage Club to summon medical assistance on my behalf and/or veterinary assistance on the behalf of my animal.

The undersigned in consideration of participating in this ride or activity, understands and acknowledges that RAVENS ROOST RANCH (OWNED BY GARY SIBERT AND SHERRY VAUGHN), an "equine sponsor" as defined by Colorado Revised Statutes, Section 13-12-119 (2)(d)(C.R.S. S13-12-119(2)(d)), is not liable or responsible for any accidents, damages, or claims which result from my participation or my horse's participation in the activity, including but not limited to the inherent risks, dangers, and/or conditions which are an integral part of equine activities, including but not limited to:

1. The propensity of the animal to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm, or death to persons in or around them.
2. The unpredictability of the animal's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement, and unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals;
3. Certain hazards such as surface and subsurface conditions;
4. Collisions with other animals or objects;
5. The potential of a participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain control over the animal or not acting within his or her ability.

Acknowledge that I am not now pregnant, and that I have no history of seizures, heart condition or other medical conditions that could be affected by horseback riding.

It is recommended that all riders wear protective helmets. If I decline to wear a helmet, initial here _____

Acknowledge that this document is a contract and agree if a lawsuit is filed against the stable or owners for any injury or damage in breach of this contract, the Undersigned will pay all attorney's fees and costs incurred by the owner's in defending such an action.

I have read this entire Release of Liability Document. I understand it is a promise not to sue and to release Ravens Roose stable and owners Gary Sibert and Sherry Vaughn and agents for all claims. I have made a free and deliberate choice to sign this Release and Waiver as a condition of participating in equine activities on Ravens Roost Ranch. I hereby waive and release Gary Sibert and Sherry Vaughn, and all other persons regardless of their capacity, their representatives, executors, heirs, and administrators, from any claim or liability of any kind of nature that I, my heirs, my executors, administrators, representatives, or any other person on my behalf might have.
